This is a hands-on workshop where you will create an file which can be uploaded to Spoonflower or another custom fabric service to create your own digital fabric. The first half of the session will be a demonstration of techniques and the second half will be where we work together to create your own custom design. Once you are familiar with the basic techniques, there is no limit to what you can create. You may use photographs, scanned drawings, artwork, or clipart to create your fabric.

Syllabus:

This workshop will cover working with photographic images using a photo editing software such as Photoshop, Photoshop Elements, Affinity, or Corel Photo Paint to create fabric designs. We will be using Adobe Photoshop in the demonstrations but will also cover options on how to achieve the results using by manually manipulating the images. We will cover the following techniques:

- Combining multiple images
- Transforming images using filters
- Creating a large-scale print
- Creating a wrap-around print
- Using various repeats
- Creating seamless prints

Required equipment:

- Laptop w/power supply and power strip
- Photo editing software that you know how to use
- Royalty-free photographs or scanned images to use in your design
