Vintage "Pocketbook" Workshop Sunday, February 12, 2017 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Taught by Tammy O'Connell

The Haute Couture Club of Chicago is pleased to host its very own Tammy O'Connell, designer and proprietor of Peacock Patterns for a full-day of purse making on Sunday, February 12, 2017.

Members will choose a purse frame or two and using their own fabrics create one or two unique "pocketbooks". You will learn how to draft your own purse pattern or use one of Tammy's patterns. There are several techniques that will be taught so that you can learn to use a variety of frames.

This workshop requires the use of your sewing machine. You will complete at least one adorable purse during this workshop with a strong possibility of a second.

Supplies to bring:

1/3 yd fashion <u>fabric</u> **and** <u>lining</u> for each purse and any desired embellishments (like beads, ribbons, lace, or a broach).

Loose beads, if desired, with appropriately sized hand needle that will go through the beads for the top of the frame to sew the bag to frame. (Seed beads are too small.)

Sewing machine, thread, marking tool, ruler (clear), scissors, and seam ripper.

Tammy will have available: Handout, drafting paper, drafting tools, interfacings, lace selection, protractor, iron, ironing board, sleeve roll, pencils, glue, rattail satin cording for handle and hardware if desired. *NOTE: Chain to match your purse frame will be available for purchase at the workshop, if you desire.*

Purse frame options for class must be purchased in advance directly from Tammy O'Connell. Choose from the purse frames below.



Cambria Purse Frame \$17.00

The elegant Cambria is 5.2" and has loops for handle. Antique gold only.



Eclipse Frame \$15.00

The Eclipse frame is 6" with a built in handle or loops to add a longer handle. The horizontal bar makes this purse frame easy to convert and add a purse bag for multiple outfits. This versatile frame comes in Gunmetal Silver.



Mirage Purse Frame

\$15.50

The Mirage purse 4.5" features a snap closure and 2 loops for handle. The purse bag is sewn to the holes in the frame. Silver and Gold plate.



Wild Rose Purse Frame \$20.00

This Victorian style frame captures the romance of the era. 6.2" with 2 loops for handle and bag attaches easily with 7 screw/washers on each side. Clasp has inset crystals! Available in Antique silver.



Olivia Purse Frame

The 6.8" Olivia Purse includes a handle and purse is attached by stitching onto frame through holes. Handle can pop out so it can be covered with a tube of fabric, if desired. Silver or Gold.



Peacock Pretty Purse Frame \$17.00

Gorgeous peacock pretty purse frame measures 4.7" with a handle with rhinestones in the clasp and two peacocks talking to each other. Holes in the frame allow the bag to be sewn to the frame. Available in antique silver and antique gold.



Steppin' Out \$17.00

Put your high heels on and step out with this adorable 6" purse frame with highheel closure. Concealed handle hinge can turn bag into a clutch, with the handle dropping into the bag. Frame of "U" channel construction with sewing holes for attachment of bag. Available in Antique Silver finish (not shown).
